# **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The 2025-2028 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Prescriptions of Australian Sailing (Download a Copy)
- 1.2 The Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2 for Off the Beach Boats will apply. (Download a Copy)
- 1.3 The Special Rules of the Skate Sailing Association of Australia (updated July 2025) will apply. (Download a Copy)

#### 2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available no later than the Competitors' Briefing.

### 3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The official series Notice Board will be located in the Ceduna Sailing Club, on the whiteboard near the entrance with notices also posted on the series page on the Skate class website at <a href="https://skatesailingaustralia.org/calendar.html">https://skatesailingaustralia.org/calendar.html</a>
- 3.2 From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

# 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Skate class registered for the current racing season.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the Entry Form available for download from the Skate Sailing Association website and submitting it with the required Entry Fee by Monday 01 December 2025.
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.4 Late entries will be accepted after 01 December 2025 at the discretion of the Organising Authority and may incur the required Late Entry Fee.

6.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

- 7.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for Heat 1 is 13:00.
- 7.4 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 16:00.

# **8** EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 8.1 Each boat shall be weighed and measured, and have any new sails measured, by approved measurers, in its Home State prior to the regatta.
- 8.2 Boats may be weighed or measured, and sails measured during the regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee.

#### 9 VENUE

9.1 Refer to Attachment A for the location of Ceduna Sailing Club and the racing area.

### 10 COURSES

10.1 A combination of windward-leeward and triangle type courses will be used.

#### 11 SCORING

- 11.1 RRS Appendix A will be used
- 11.2 Five races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.3 When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.4 When six or seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

#### 12 RISK STATEMENT

- 12.1 RRS 3 DECISION TO RACE states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 12.2 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

# 13 INSURANCE

13.1 Competitors are required to have insurance with third party liability cover of up to \$10M to cover risks arising while the competitor is participating in the regatta, whether ashore or afloat.
